COMPANY OVERVIEW

Southwest Wyoming Wireless Connect (SWWWC) is a locally owned fixed-wireless broadband operator founded in 2004. For 21 years we have built and operated our own tower network across southwest Wyoming: 32+ tower sites spanning a 6,400+ square mile service territory and seven communities. SWWWC runs a 24/7 in-house network operations center, employs local tower crews, and is not dependent on out-of-state contractors. We deliver service into areas national carriers have historically declined to serve.

KEY DIFFERENTIATORS vs. NATIONAL CARRIERS

21-year incumbent operating presence in SW Wyoming - national carriers typically decline to invest in low-density counties.

Self-funded capital expenditures; not reliant on incumbent build cycles.

Local tower crews stationed in the served territory - same-day and next-day response versus multi-day dispatch.

Flat monthly price: no data caps, no overage fees, no contracts (residential).

Direct engineering ownership of last-mile links - no subcontractor layer between SWWWWC and the customer.
